AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, line 17, strike the enacting clause

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 3, Section 1, lines 29 through page 4, line
3, delete all of subsection 13 and insert

"(13) The State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board
will not have the authority to enter into a contract with out-of-
state providers in connection with any PPO or hospital or medical
network plan; provided however, said Board may ~~process medical~~
~~claims in catastrophic or emergency situations by (1) eliminating~~
~~any per confinement deductible and (2) allowing covered medical~~
~~expense up to usual and prevailing charges~~ extend the benefits of
the network to any participating employee or dependent who:

(a) is referred to an out-of-state hospital by a physician
located in this state; or

(b) must be treated by an out-of-state provider for a
catastrophic or an emergency situation.

These exceptions will only be allowed ~~according to~~ in accordance
with rules ~~defined~~ adopted by the Board ~~and by~~ requiring prior
approval ~~as to catastrophic illness expenses~~ except as provided in
paragraph (b) of this subsection."
