and on line 31, after the word "by" and before the
word "secondary", delete the words "elementary or"

and on page 2, Section 3, line 7, after the word
"for" delete the words "elementary and"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, Section 3, line 6, after the word
"districts" and before the word "establish" delete
the words "are authorized to" and insert the word
"may"

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, Section 3, line 10, delete the language
beginning with the word "For" through the period
on line 12 and insert

"A student may receive elective credit for participating in a youth
community service program as long as the outcomes of the program
reflect the competencies outlined in the Oklahoma Learner Outcomes
adopted by the State Board of Education."

and on page 1, lines 10 through 10 1/2, in the title, after the word "AN" and before the semicolon, delete the words "ELECTIVE COURSE FOR PURPOSES OF GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS" and insert the words "EDUCATION CREDIT"

AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 2, Section 4, line 21, after the word "Education" and before the word "assist", delete the word "shall" and insert the word "may"

AMENDMENT NO. 5. Page 3, Section 4, line 6 1/2, add a new paragraph to read

"8. For the purpose of implementing this act the State Board of Education shall utilize only grants from private and governmental sources."

and on line 4, after the semicolon, delete the word "and"

and on line 6, delete the period and insert ";
and"
