AN ACT RELATING TO ANIMALS; DEFINING TERMS; PROVIDING  
FOR CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION FOR CERTAIN DOGS;  
ALLOWING CERTAIN DOGS IN THIS STATE UNDER CERTAIN  
CONDITIONS; PROHIBITING CERTAIN DOGS OUTSIDE PROPER  
ENCLOSURE; PROVIDING EXCEPTION; AUTHORIZING  
CONFISCATION OF CERTAIN DOGS BY ANIMAL CONTROL  
AUTHORITIES; ESTABLISHING CRIMINAL PENALTIES;  
PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE.

- AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, Section 1, lines 23 and 24, after the word  
"that" on line 23 and before the colon on line 24  
delete the words "according to the records of the  
appropriate authority"
- AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, Section 1, line 33, after the word "or"  
and before the word "lacerations" delete the word  
"disfiguring"
- AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, Section 1, line 6, after the word "of" and  
before the word "children" delete the word "young"
- AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 3, Section 3, lines 31 and 32, after the word  
"authorities" on line 31 and before the period on  
line 32 delete the words ", provided the  
regulations are not breed specific"
- AMENDMENT NO. 5. Page 3, Section 3, line 32, after the period  
insert

"Nothing in this act shall prohibit such local governments from enforcing penalties for violation of such local laws."

AMENDMENT NO. 6. Page 4, Section 4, line 23 1/2, insert a new paragraph to read

"It is the purpose of this act to provide additional and cumulative remedies to control dangerous and potentially dangerous dogs in this state. Nothing in this act shall be construed to abridge or alter rights of action or remedies of victims under the common law or statutory law, criminal or civil."

and page 1, line 11 in the title, after the word "PENALTIES;" and before the word "PROVIDING" insert "STATING PURPOSE AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE ACT;"
