PENSION AND RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND THE OKLAHOMA

POLICE PENSION AND RETIREMENT SYSTEM; PROVIDING AN

EXCEPTION TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL BENEFITS

SHALL BE PAID BY CERTAIN RETIREMENT SYSTEMS;

CLARIFYING THE REQUIREMENT THAT CERTAIN EMPLOYERS

ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PAYMENT OF SALARY WHEN

CERTAIN EMPLOYEES ARE DISABLED FOR A PERIOD OF NOT

LESS THAN SIX MONTHS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 2, Section 2, line 12 and page 3, Section 4,  
line 7, after the period insert

"Any such member shall not receive more than his normal full salary  
from the municipality due to any and all statutory entitlements for  
any work-related injury or disease."

and page 1, in the title, line 12, after the word  
"MONTHS;" insert

"LIMITING AMOUNT THAT AN EMPLOYEE IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE  
DURING DISABLEMENT;"
