AN ACT RELATING TO REVENUE AND TAXATION; AMENDING
SECTION 4, CHAPTER 138, O.S.L. 1984, AS LAST
AMENDED BY SECTION 8, CHAPTER 41, O.S.L. 1986 (68
O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 6003), WHICH RELATES TO
EXEMPTIONS FROM THE AIRCRAFT EXCISE TAX; EXEMPTING
AIRCRAFT USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR AGRICULTURAL SPRAYING
PURPOSES; DEFINING TERM; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, lines 8 through 11 1/2, strike the title
to read

"[REVENUE AND TAXATION - AMENDING 68 O.S.,
SECTION 6003 - EXEMPTIONS FROM AIRCRAFT EXCISE
TAX -
EMERGENCY]"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 3, Section 1, line 6, after the word
"purchased" and before the word "and" insert the words
"by a resident of this state"

and on page 3, Section 1, line 6, after the word
"exclusively" and before the word "for" insert the words

"in this state"

and on page 3, Section 1, line 7, after the word "purposes" and before the period insert the words

"; provided, if such aircraft is sold, leased or used outside this state or for a purpose other than agricultural spraying at any time within three (3) years from the date of purchase, the excise tax levied pursuant to the provisions of Section 6002 of this title shall be due and payable"
