AN ACT RELATING TO REVENUE AND TAXATION; PROHIBITING
CERTAIN INMATES IN THE CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
CORRECTIONS FROM BEING ELIGIBLE TO FILE CLAIMS FOR
CERTAIN SALES TAX RELIEF; PROVIDING THAT OTHER
MEMBERS OF THE HOUSEHOLDS OF SUCH INMATES ARE NOT
PROHIBITED FROM FILING CERTAIN CLAIMS; PROVIDING
CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
