"studies," and before the word "literature" delete the  
words "Oklahoma History," and insert the words

"the history of Oklahoma and America,"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, line 20 1/2, insert a new Section 2 to  
read

"SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1981, Section 24-119, as  
amended by Section 6, Chapter 326, O.S.L. 1982 (70 O.S. Supp. 1990,  
Section 24-119), is amended to read as follows:

Section 24-119. The State Board of Education ~~may~~ shall adopt necessary rules and regulations providing coverage of the outstanding events involving and surrounding the history of the ~~Negro~~ African American race and other minority races and the development of their cultures."

and renumber subsequent sections

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 1, line 9 1/2, amend the title to read

"AN ACT RELATING TO SCHOOLS; AMENDING SECTION 6, CHAPTER 2, O.S.L. SUPP. 1989, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 67, CHAPTER 263, O.S.L. 1990 AND 70 O.S. 1981, SECTION 24-119, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 6, CHAPTER 326, O.S.L. 1982 (70 O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTIONS 11-103.6 AND 24-119), WHICH RELATE TO CURRICULUM STANDARDS AND THE HISTORY OF RACIAL MINORITIES; EXPANDING LIST OF SUBJECTS WHICH MUST BE STUDIED; MODIFYING LANGUAGE; REMOVING DISCRETION AS TO ADOPTION OF CERTAIN RULES AND REGULATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."
