AN ACT RELATING TO CRIMES AND PUNISHMENT; PROHIBITING
USE OF AUTOMATED SYSTEMS FOR THE SELECTION OR
DIALING OF TELEPHONE NUMBERS AND PLAYING OF A
RECORDED MESSAGE; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS; PROVIDING
PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF; MAKING
CERTAIN CONTRACTS VOIDABLE; PROHIBITING THE
CONVEYING OF INFORMATION ABOUT CANDIDATES BY USE OF
AN AUTOMATED DIALING TELEPHONE SYSTEM; PROVIDING
FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

"purchased" and before the period insert the words

"or a list of customers who have made a written
request to be called"

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, line 18 1/2, insert a new Section 2 to
read

"SECTION 2. The provisions of this act are severable and if
any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the
court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining
parts or provisions of this act."
