AN ACT RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT; AMENDING 74 O.S.
1981, SECTION 96, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 119,
CHAPTER 304, O.S.L. 1983 (74 O.S. SUPP. 1990,
SECTION 96), WHICH RELATES TO TRANSFERS OF EXCESS
STATE PROPERTY; DELETING CERTAIN RESTRICTION;
AUTHORIZING TRANSFERS TO CERTAIN GOVERNMENTAL
ENTITIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill
and insert

"AN ACT RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT; AMENDING 74 O.S. 1981,
SECTION 96, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 119, CHAPTER 304, O.S.L.
1983 (74 O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 96), WHICH RELATES TO
TRANSFERS OF EXCESS STATE PROPERTY; AUTHORIZING TRANSFERS
TO CERTAIN POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS; STATING REQUIREMENTS FOR
TRANSFER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1981, Section 96, as
amended by Section 119, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 1983 (74 O.S. Supp.
1990, Section 96), is amended to read as follows:

Section 96. ~~In order that~~ A. When state property now located in one department or institution, which has been purchased out of an appropriation, specifically set up for such department or institution, which is not needed by such department or institution and is needed in other divisions of government, the Office of Public Affairs is hereby authorized to cause the transfer of such property to any department or institution in need of such excess property.

B. The Office of Public Affairs is authorized to cause the transfer of surplus property to any political subdivision of the state when such property is not needed by agencies, departments or institutions of the state and the use of the property by a political subdivision will benefit citizens of the state within or outside of that political subdivision. Property transferred pursuant to this subsection shall revert back to the state at such time as the property is no longer used by the political subdivision for the purpose transferred.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1991.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
