AN ACT RELATING TO THE STATE ARTS COUNCIL; MAKING AN
APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE ARTS COUNCIL; STATING
THE PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR DUTIES AND COMPENSATION
OF EMPLOYEES; LIMITING SALARY OF THE CHIEF
ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF
FULL-TIME-EQUIVALENT EMPLOYEES; LIMITING CERTAIN
EXPENDITURES; PROVIDING A LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and the entire
bill and insert

"AN ACT RELATING TO THE STATE ARTS COUNCIL; MAKING AN
APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE ARTS COUNCIL; STATING THE
PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF
EMPLOYEES; LIMITING SALARY OF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE
OFFICER; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF FULL-TIME-EQUIVALENT
EMPLOYEES; LIMITING CERTAIN EXPENDITURES; PROVIDING A LAPSE
DATE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Arts Council from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the following amount or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Arts Council by law:

Community Arts Program	2,206,061.00
Other Operating Expenses	<u>111,626.00</u>
TOTAL OPERATIONS	\$3,015,635.00

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Arts Council by law shall be set by the Council. The salary of the Chief Administrative Officer shall not exceed Forty-one Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$41,400.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992. The State Arts Council for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. In addition to other budgetary limitations set by law, the State Arts Council shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations which shall be maximum expenditure limits for the listed programs for operations during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992:

Artists-in-Residence	\$324,761.00
Community Arts Programs	\$2,883,736.00

SECTION 4. Funds appropriated for Artists-in-Schools programs shall be used to provide financial assistance to cover a portion of the cost of artists' fees during residencies in public schools throughout the state.

SECTION 5. The appropriation made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 1991.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
