AN ACT RELATING TO AIRCRAFT AND AIRPORTS; PROHIBITING
CERTAIN ACTS BY PERSONS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF
INTOXICANTS; DEFINING TERM; PROVIDING PENALTIES;
PROVIDING FOR IMPLIED CONSENT FOR TESTING FOR
INTOXICANTS; PROVIDING PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS
FOR TESTING; PROVIDING FOR RULES AND REGULATIONS;
PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FOR TESTING; PROVIDING FOR
IMMUNITY FOR PERSONS OR FACILITIES ADMINISTERING
TESTING; REQUIRING CERTAIN WRITTEN REPORT;
PROVIDING FOR REFUSAL TO SUBMIT TO TESTING;
PROVIDING THAT REFUSAL TO SUBMIT TO TESTING IS
ADMISSIBLE AS EVIDENCE; PROHIBITING CERTAIN PERSONS
FROM ALLOWING INTOXICATED PERSONS TO OPERATE
AIRCRAFT AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR;
PROVIDING FOR THE INTRODUCTION OF OTHER COMPETENT
EVIDENCE OF INTOXICATION; AMENDING 47 O.S. 1981,
SECTION 759, AS LAST AMENDED BY SECTION 6, CHAPTER
225, O.S.L. 1988 (47 O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 759),
WHICH RELATES TO THE BOARD OF TESTS FOR ALCOHOL AND
DRUG INFLUENCE; MODIFYING DUTIES OF THE BOARD;
PROVIDING CERTAIN RECORDING REQUIREMENTS FOR CIVIL
AIRCRAFT; PROHIBITING CERTAIN ACTS; PROVIDING
PENALTIES; PROHIBITING THE EQUIPPING OF AIRCRAFT
WITH CERTAIN CONTAINERS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY
THEREFOR; PROVIDING FOR SEIZURE AND FORFEITURE IN

CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; AMENDING SECTION 1, CHAPTER
55, O.S.L. 1987 (21 O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 1738),
WHICH RELATES TO SEIZURE AND FORFEITURE
PROCEEDINGS; EXPANDING SCOPE OF PROVISIONS;
PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.
