AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, line 9, restore the stricken title to
read

AN ACT RELATING TO OKLAHOMA HISTORICAL SOCIETIES;
PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN PROPERTIES,
FUNDS, RECORDS, PERSONNEL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY
FROM THE OKLAHOMA TOURISM AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT
TO THE OKLAHOMA HISTORICAL SOCIETY; PROVIDING FOR
POWERS, DUTIES AND ASSUMPTION OF OBLIGATIONS
RELATED TO SUCH PROPERTIES; PROVIDING FOR
LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL OF THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN
PROPERTY BY THE OKLAHOMA HISTORICAL SOCIETY;
PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 7, Section 1, line 30 1/2, add a new paragraph 10 to read

"10. Spiro Mounds - A tract of land in LeFlore County, State of Oklahoma, described as the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 10 North, Range 26 East, and all buildings and improvements situated on a tract of land in LeFlore County, leased to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department by the United States of America, Lease #DACW56-1-71-1078 and all supplements thereto, containing 138.83 acres."
