AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY; CREATING  
THE PERSONAL WATERCRAFT SAFETY ACT; PROVIDING SHORT  
TITLE; DEFINING TERMS; PROHIBITING CERTAIN ACTS;  
PROVIDING EXCLUSIONS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 2, Section 3, line 1, after the word  
"watercraft"

and on Page 2, Section 3, line 4, after the word  
"watercraft"

and on Page 2, Section 3, line 6, after the word  
"watercraft" insert the words

"or specialty prop-craft" in all three places

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, Section 4, line 15, after the semicolon  
insert the word

"or"

and on Page 2, Section 4, lines 18 and 19, after  
the word "exhibition" on line 18, and before the period on  
line 19, delete the word "; or" on line 18 and all  
language on line 19

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, line 19 1/2, insert a new Section 5 to  
read

"SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4220.4 of Title 63, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be punished by a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)."

and renumber subsequent sections

AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 2, line 19 1/2, insert new Sections 6 and 7 to read

"SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4035.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Upon application, there shall be assigned and issued up to ten (10) manufacturer's testing permits to manufacturers of new boats or motors. Such permits shall be displayed upon each vessel or motor owned by the manufacturer when the vessel or motor is driven or tested on the waters of this state. No such tester permit shall be used upon any new vessel or motor which is for private use or for hire.

The manufacturer's testing permit shall be provided at a cost of Five Dollars (\$5.00) each and shall expire on December 31 of each year.

SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4039.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any currently licensed Oklahoma boat dealer owning a commercial marina on the waters of this state may dock his boats for sale at his marina."

AMENDMENT NO. 5. Page 1, line 9, in the title, after the word "EXCLUSIONS;" and before the word "PROVIDING" insert the words

"PROVIDING PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN PERMITS; ESTABLISHING COST OF CERTAIN PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR DOCKING OF BOATS AT CERTAIN MARINAS;
