AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, Section 1, line 31, before the word "the"
delete the word "limit"

and on page 1, Section 1, line 31, after the word
"the" and before the word "persons" delete the words
"number of"

and on page 1, Section 1, lines 31 and 32, after
the word "entities" on line 31 and before the word
"providing" on line 32, delete the words "or to prohibit
any person or entity from"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, line 34, insert a new Section 2 to read

"SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 139.3 of Title 17, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Nothing herein shall prevent the private ownership and operation
of a coin-operated, coinless operated or credit card-activated
telephones for public use."

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 1, line 7, restore the title to read

AN ACT RELATING TO THE CORPORATION COMMISSION;

AMENDING SECTION 1, CHAPTER 285, O.S.L. 1990 (17

O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 139.1), WHICH RELATES TO
COIN-ACTIVATED AND CREDIT CARD-ACTIVATED
TELEPHONES; REGULATING COINLESS TELEPHONES;
PROVIDING CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR
RETENTION OF CERTAIN POWERS; LIMITING OPERATION OF
STATUTE; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY."
