AN ACT RELATING TO OFFICERS; AMENDING 47 O.S. 1991,
SECTION 2-105, WHICH RELATES TO PERSONNEL OF THE
OKLAHOMA HIGHWAY PATROL DIVISION; AUTHORIZING
CERTAIN PERSONNEL OF THE OKLAHOMA HIGHWAY PATROL
DIVISION TO BECOME CANDIDATES FOR LOCAL SCHOOL
BOARD POSITIONS; AMENDING 51 O.S. 1991, SECTION 6,
WHICH RELATES TO DUAL OFFICE HOLDING; MODIFYING AND
ADDING EXCEPTIONS TO THE DUAL OFFICE HOLDING
PROHIBITION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 2, Section 1, lines 15 through 17, after the
word "member" on line 15 delete the comma and before the
first word "of" on line 17 delete all language

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 6, Section 2, lines 4 through 11, after the
word "provided," on line 4, restore all stricken language
through the stricken word "education" on line 7, and

delete all new language on line 7 through the
word "office" on line 11

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 6, Section 2, lines 12 and 13, after the
word "member" on line 12 and before the first word "of" on
line 13 delete all language

AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 6, Section 2, line 15 1/2, insert a new
paragraph 10 to read

"10. any District Supervisor, Assistant District Supervisor,
Team Supervisor, Parole Officer 1 or Parole Officer 2 of the

Department of Corrections who is elected or appointed to a city council;"

and renumber subsequent paragraphs

AMENDMENT NO. 5. Page 1, lines 7 1/2 through 11 1/2, amend the title to conform

"AN ACT RELATING TO OFFICERS; AMENDING 47 O.S. 1991, SECTION 2-105, WHICH RELATES TO PERSONNEL OF THE OKLAHOMA HIGHWAY PATROL DIVISION; ALLOWING MEMBERS OF THE OKLAHOMA HIGHWAY PATROL DIVISION TO BECOME CANDIDATES FOR LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD POSITIONS; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN PERSONNEL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO BECOME CANDIDATES FOR CITY COUNCILS; AMENDING 51 O.S. 1991, SECTION 6, WHICH RELATES TO DUAL OFFICE HOLDING; MODIFYING AND ADDING EXCEPTIONS TO THE DUAL OFFICE HOLDING PROHIBITION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."
