AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 5, line 27 1/2, insert a new Section 5 to
read

"SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.44C of Title 74, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

It shall be unlawful for the State of Oklahoma to enter into any
contract which provides for the state to furnish goods to be used by
the party contracting with the state in the performance of the
contract, if the contract allows the contracting party to acquire
ownership of the goods during or after the term of the contract in
any manner other than through a public bidding or auction
procedure."

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, restore the title to read

AN ACT RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT; AMENDING 74 O.S.
1991, SECTIONS 85.41 AND 89, WHICH RELATE TO
CONTRACTS; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENTS FOR SERVICES AT A
UNIFORM RATE THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF CERTAIN
CONTRACTS; ALLOWING CERTAIN NONUNIFORM PAYMENTS
UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; REQUIRING STATE
AGENCIES TO DESCRIBE EFFORTS TO SOLICIT BIDS FOR
CERTAIN SERVICES OR PRODUCTS IN CERTAIN SOLE SOURCE
AFFIDAVITS; PROVIDING CERTAIN COURT ORDERS SHALL
NOT CONSTITUTE OR SUBSTITUTE FOR CERTAIN REQUIRED
AFFIDAVITS; STATING CERTAIN COURT ORDERS SHALL NOT
INVALIDATE CERTAIN COMPETITIVE BIDDING
REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENTS FOR PRODUCTS
OR SERVICES BE MADE AFTER PRODUCTS HAVE BEEN
PROVIDED OR SERVICES RENDERED; PROHIBITING
CONTRACTS PROVIDING GOODS USED BY CONTRACTING PARTY
ALLOWING OWNERSHIP OF GOODS DURING OR AFTER TERMS
OF CONTRACT; ALLOWING PURCHASE THROUGH PUBLIC
BIDDING OR AUCTION; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."
