AN ACT RELATING TO LABOR; AMENDING 40 O.S. 1991,  
SECTIONS 402, 403, 410, 412, 414 AND 417, WHICH  
RELATE TO OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY; MODIFYING  
DEFINITIONS; MODIFYING CERTAIN EMPLOYER DUTIES;  
PROVIDING CERTAIN PROHIBITIONS AGAINST RETALIATION;  
REQUIRING CERTAIN REPORT; REQUIRING CERTAIN SAFETY  
INSPECTIONS; MODIFYING CERTAIN LANGUAGE; MODIFYING  
CERTAIN OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES; DELETING AND  
MODIFYING CERTAIN LANGUAGE; PROVIDING CERTAIN  
REFERENCES; AMENDING 63 O.S. 1991, SECTION 1-323,  
WHICH RELATES TO VITAL STATISTICS RECORDS;  
REQUIRING THE TRANSMISSION OF CERTAIN STATISTICS;  
PROHIBITING CERTAIN CONDUCT BY AN EMPLOYER;  
PROVIDING PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, line 16 1/2, insert a new SECTION 1 to  
read

"SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 1991, Section 141.5, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 141.5 A. The maximum allowable working pressure of a  
boiler stamped with the American Society of Mechanical Engineers  
Code symbol or a pressure vessel stamped with the American Society

of Mechanical Engineers or American Petroleum Institute - American Society of Mechanical Engineers Code symbol shall be determined by the applicable sections of the code under which it was constructed and stamped.

B. The maximum allowable working pressure of a boiler or pressure vessel which is not stamped and does not carry the ASME or the API-ASME Code symbol shall be computed in accordance with standard engineering practice using a factor of safety established by rules adopted by the Commissioner of Labor.

C. This act shall not be construed as in any way preventing the use, sale or reinstallation of a boiler or pressure vessel referred to in subsection B of this section, provided the Commissioner of Labor gives a specific ruling that such boiler or pressure vessel conforms to its rules and regulations, and provided further, upon inspection it has been found to be in safe condition.

D. If a boiler or pressure vessel is of historical significance and cannot comply with the construction requirements of the rules and regulations of this act, a special installation and operating permit may be granted by the Commissioner. Such boilers and pressure vessels are exempt from the fee set forth in subparagraph f of paragraph 2 of subsection A of Section 141.16 of this title."

and renumber subsequent sections

and in the title, page 1, line 5 1/2, after the word "SECTIONS" and before the numeral "402" insert the numeral "141.5,"

and in the title, page 1, line 6, after the semicolon insert the words

"EXEMPTING CERTAIN BOILERS AND PRESSURE VESSELS FROM CERTAIN FEES;"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, Section 2, lines 9 through 13, restore the stricken language and delete all new language on lines 13 through 16

and in the title, page 1, lines 6 1/2 and 7, delete the language

"MODIFYING CERTAIN EMPLOYER DUTIES;"

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 8, lines 15 through 35, and page 9, lines 1 through 7, delete all of SECTION 6 and renumber subsequent sections

and in the title, page 1, line 5 1/2, delete the word and numeral "AND 417" and after the numeral "412" delete the comma and insert the word "AND"
