AN ACT RELATING TO CEMETERIES; PROVIDING FOR INGRESS
AND EGRESS FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES TO ABANDONED
CEMETERIES SURROUNDED BY PRIVATE LAND; DEFINING
TERM; REQUIRING FEDERAL AND STATE DEPARTMENTS AND
AGENCIES TO TAKE CERTAIN ACTION WHEN ENCOUNTERING
BURIAL GROUNDS, HUMAN SKELETAL REMAINS OR BURIAL
FURNITURE; REQUIRING STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION
OFFICER TO WORK WITH AGENCY OR DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR
UNTIL DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN BURIAL GROUNDS, HUMAN
SKELETAL REMAINS OR BURIAL FURNITURE IS COMPLETED;
PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, Section 1, lines 20 and 29, after the
word "Any" and before the word "who" on line 20, delete
the word "person" and on line 29, before the word "who"
delete the word "person" and insert the words

"relative of the deceased" in both places and in
the title line 7 1/2, after the word "EGRESS" and before
the word "FOR" insert the words

"OF CERTAIN PERSONS"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, Section 1, line 27, after the word
"where" and before the word "skeletal" insert the word

"human"

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 1, Section 1, line 28, after the word "years" and before the period, insert the words

"and where such site is readily identifiable as a cemetery by an inspection of the property"

AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 1, Section 1, line 30, after the word "owners" and before the word "tenants" delete the word "or", and insert the word

"and"

AMENDMENT NO. 5. Page 1, Section 1, line 30, after the word "tenants" and before the word "of" insert the words

", if any,"

AMENDMENT NO. 6. Page 1, Section 1, line 31, after the word "cemetery." insert the words

"This section shall not be interpreted to allow the creation of an easement or claim of easement nor a right of ownership or claim of right of ownership to an abandoned cemetery."

and in the title on line 12, after the semicolon and before the word "PROVIDING" insert the words

"CONSTRUING CERTAIN SECTION OF LAW;"
