AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, lines 8 1/2 through 10 1/2, restore the
title to read

AN ACT RELATING TO COUNTIES AND COUNTY OFFICERS;
ENACTING THE COUNTY HOME RULE CHARTER ACT;
PROVIDING SHORT TITLE; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN COUNTIES
TO ADOPT OR AMEND A COUNTY HOME RULE CHARTER;
PROHIBITING CHARTER FROM BEING INCONSISTENT WITH
POLICIES OF THE STATE; PROVIDING FOR DESIGNATION OF
COMMISSION MEMBERS AND FILING OF NAMES; PROVIDING
FOR SUBMISSION OF CERTAIN QUESTIONS TO VOTERS;
CONSTRUING ACT; REQUIRING ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING
UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; AUTHORIZING SELECTION
OF OFFICERS; ADOPTING OF CERTAIN RULES AND DRAFTING
OF PROPOSED COUNTY HOME RULE CHARTER; REQUIRING
COMPLETION OF COMMISSION'S WORK WITHIN CERTAIN TIME

PERIOD; REQUIRING CERTAIN PUBLICATION; REQUIRING COPIES OF PROPOSED CHARTER OR AMENDMENTS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR DISTRIBUTION; REQUIRING SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED CHARTER OR AMENDMENTS BE SUBMITTED TO VOTERS AND SPECIFYING FORM OF QUESTION; PROVIDING THAT CHARTER OR AMENDMENTS BECOME EFFECTIVE UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; PROVIDING FOR TERMS OF GOVERNING BODY; REQUIRING STRUCTURE OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT AND MANNER IN WHICH IT IS TO PERFORM TO BE SET FORTH IN CHARTER; SETTING FORTH CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS TO BE CONTAINED IN CHARTER; PROVIDING FOR THE EXERCISE OF CERTAIN POWERS AND DUTIES BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY; REQUIRING AUTHORIZATION OF CERTAIN OBLIGATIONS AND TAX BY VOTERS; PROVIDING PROCEDURES FOR ISSUANCE OF COUNTY OBLIGATIONS; REQUIRING ADOPTED CHARTERS TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN PROVISIONS SUBJECT TO VOTER APPROVAL; STATING THAT PROVISIONS OF ACT BE SELF-EXECUTING; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."
