COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE AN ACT RELATING TO THE OKLAHOMA HISTORICAL
SOCIETY; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THERETO; STATING THE PURPOSE;
PROVIDING FOR THE DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES; LIMITING THE
SALARY OF THE DIRECTOR; PROVIDING BUDGETARY LIMITATIONS; REQUIRING
THE PLACEMENT OF CERTAIN DONATION RECEPTACLES AT CERTAIN MUSEUMS AND
HISTORIC SITES; STATING PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR DEPOSITS AND
EXPENDITURES OF CERTAIN MONIES; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION;
PROVIDING LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN OPERATIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
Historical Society from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 1992, the following amount or so much thereof as may
be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma
Historical Society by law:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Forty-nine Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$49,400.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992. The Oklahoma Historical Society for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1.20 of Title 53, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Each Oklahoma museum or historical site supported by state funds shall provide a donation receptacle at the museum or historical site operated under the authority of the State of Oklahoma. The donation receptacles shall be for the purpose of the collection of voluntary donations of monies made by visitors to the museums and historical sites. Any monies collected in any such donation receptacle shall be deposited in an account or the revolving fund established for that specific museum or historical site for the purposes of funding renovations of the museum or historical site, acquisitions of artifacts, and other expenditures necessary for the operation, maintenance and expansion of the museum or historical site.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 5. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
