COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

AN ACT RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR; MAKING
AN APPROPRIATION THERETO; STATING THE PURPOSES;
PROVIDING FOR THE DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF
EMPLOYEES; MAKING APPROPRIATION NONFISCAL;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
30, 1992, the following amount or so much thereof as may be required
for the following purposes:

Personal services, operating

expenses and extraordinary protection

of the state

\$1,915,101.00

For payment of official and necessary

expenses during occupancy of

the Governor's Mansion and	
to perform the duties of the	
Governor's Office pursuant to	
Section 7 of Title 74 of the	
Oklahoma Statutes	<u>26,801.00</u>
TOTAL	\$1,941,902.00

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Governor by law shall be set by the Governor.

SECTION 3. The appropriation made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1991.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
