COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

AN ACT RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF PERSONNEL

MANAGEMENT; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THERETO;  
STATING PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR THE DUTIES AND  
COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES; LIMITING THE SALARY OF  
THE ADMINISTRATOR; PROVIDING BUDGETARY LIMITATIONS;  
PROVIDING A LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN OPERATIVE; AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of  
Personnel Management from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
ending June 30, 1992, the following amount or so much thereof as may  
be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of  
Personnel Management by law:

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of Personnel Management from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of Five Hundred Seventy-seven Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-nine Dollars (\$577,579.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the State Employees Flexible Benefits Plan. The appropriation made in this section shall be expended exclusively for the purpose so stated and shall not be transferable.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of Personnel Management from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for Day Care programs. The appropriation made in this section shall be expended exclusively for this purpose so stated and shall not be transferable.

SECTION 4. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) of the amount of Four Million Four Hundred Thirty-three Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-nine Dollars (\$4,433,769.00), originally appropriated by Section 1, Chapter 10, O.S.L. 1990, as amended by Section 70, Chapter 264, O.S.L. 1990, to The Office of Personnel Management, from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1991, not otherwise appropriated, for Personal Services and Other Operating Expenses is hereby continued and reappropriated for the purpose of ongoing automation projects, as

adjusted by transfer, less any amount that has been expended upon the effective date of this act.

SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of Personnel Management by law shall be set by the Administrator. The salary of the Administrator shall not exceed Fifty-six Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$56,400.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992. The Office of Personnel Management for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects and those expenditures made from the Flexible Benefits Revolving Fund, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 6. The appropriation made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 7. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
