COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE AN ACT RELATING TO THE J.M. DAVIS MEMORIAL  
COMMISSION; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THERETO; STATING THE PURPOSE;  
PROVIDING FOR DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES; LIMITING THE  
SALARY OF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF  
FULL-TIME-EQUIVALENT EMPLOYEES; LIMITING CERTAIN EXPENDITURES;  
PROVIDING A LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING  
AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the J.M. Davis  
Memorial Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
ending June 30, 1992, the following amount or so much thereof as may  
be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the J.M. Davis  
Memorial Commission by law:
