AN ACT RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH; AMENDING 63 O.S.
1981, SECTION 2109, AS RENUMBERED BY SECTION 104,
CHAPTER 103, O.S.L. 1986, AND AS LAST AMENDED BY
SECTION 77, CHAPTER 51, O.S.L. 1990 (43A O.S. SUPP.
1990, SECTION 3-404), WHICH RELATES TO THE ALCOHOL
AND DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION, TRAINING, TREATMENT AND
REHABILITATION AUTHORITY; RE-CREATING THE ALCOHOL
AND DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION, TRAINING, TREATMENT AND
REHABILITATION AUTHORITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1981, Section 2109, as
renumbered by Section 104, Chapter 103, O.S.L. 1986, and as last
amended by Section 77, Chapter 51, O.S.L. 1990 (43A O.S. Supp. 1990,
Section 3-404), is amended to read as follows:

Section 3-404. There is hereby re-created, to continue until
July 1, ~~1991~~ 1997, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma
Sunset Law, Sections 3901 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
Statutes, the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention, Training, Treatment
and Rehabilitation Authority for the State of Oklahoma. The
Authority shall be the Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse

Services. As such Authority, the Board will be responsible for verifying the need for, and certifying, the treatment program for any alcoholism or drug abuse treatment facility established or to be established in Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1991.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
