AN ACT RELATING TO CRIMINAL PROCEDURE; PROHIBITING
DISCHARGE OF COURT ORDERED RESTITUTION AND CERTAIN
ASSESSMENTS THROUGH BANKRUPTCY; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 991g of Title 22, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person ordered to pay restitution or an assessment imposed
pursuant to victim's compensation under, but not limited to, the
provisions of Section 142.18 of Title 21, and Sections 991a and
991a-10 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall not be able to
discharge such debt under the United States Bankruptcy Code found in
Title 11 of the United States Code.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
