AN ACT RELATING TO TORTS; LIMITING LIABILITY OF
LANDOWNERS IN REGARD TO TRESPASSERS; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 30 of Title 76, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

An owner, lessee, or occupant of land:

1. Does not owe a duty of care to a trespasser on the land; and
2. Is not liable for any injury to a trespasser on the land,
except for willful or wanton acts or gross negligence by the owner,
lessee, or other occupant of land.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
