AN ACT RELATING TO THE OKLAHOMA HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THERETO;
STATING PURPOSES; MAKING APPROPRIATION NONFISCAL;
PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma House of Representatives from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the amount of Twelve Million Sixty-seven Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-eight Dollars (\$12,067,488.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay the salaries, per diem, and expenses of the members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the salaries of the employees of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and other necessary expenses.

SECTION 2. Claims and payrolls filed against the appropriation made by Section 1 of this act shall be approved by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

SECTION 3. The appropriation made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for

encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1991.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
