AN ACT RELATING TO THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICE BUREAU;
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THERETO; STATING THE
PURPOSE; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN EXPENDITURES; MAKING
APPROPRIATION NONFISCAL; PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the amount of Three Million One Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$3,188,900.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Legislative Service Bureau by law.

SECTION 2. The Legislative Service Bureau is hereby authorized to pay, from monies appropriated by Section 1 of this act, an amount not to exceed Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) as the State of Oklahoma assessment for the Southwest Regional Energy Council.

SECTION 3. The appropriation made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for

encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1991.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
