BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

STATE ARTS COUNCIL

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Arts Council from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the amount of _____ Dollars (\$_____.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Arts Council by law.

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Arts Council by law shall be set by the Council. The salary of the Chief Administrative Officer shall not exceed Forty-one Thousand Dollars (\$41,000.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992. The State Arts Council for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special

projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

OKLAHOMA EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION AUTHORITY

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the amount of _____ Dollars (\$ _____ .00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority by law.

SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-one Thousand Dollars (\$51,000.00) per annum, payable monthly

for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992. The Oklahoma Educational Television Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 6. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 7. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
