AN ACT RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE;

AUTHORIZING CERTAIN GRANTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF DRY
HYDRANTS; PROVIDING FOR ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. If the legislature makes a line item appropriation to fund this act, the Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall make funds available to all substate multicounty planning districts as grants to facilitate the construction of dry hydrants throughout each district. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall establish eligibility requirements that substate multicounty planning districts must meet in order to receive grants from appropriations to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1991.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
