AN ACT RELATING TO CITIES AND TOWNS; AMENDING 11 O.S.
1981, SECTION 33-202, WHICH RELATES TO THE RIGHT OF
MUNICIPALITIES TO LEASE CERTAIN WATERWAYS;
AUTHORIZING LEASES FOR CERTAIN COMMERCIAL PURPOSES
UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS; AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 1981, Section 33-202, is amended to read as follows:

Section 33-202. No lease issued under the authority of Section 33-201 of this title shall be for a longer period than ten (10) years, nor shall any lease be given to any individual, corporation, or stock company which has for its purpose the propagation of fish for commercial purposes unless the governing body of the municipality determines that the lake, pond, stream, water course or reservoir has not been used for at least three (3) years for amusement or recreational purposes. However, if a lease contains a provision that the premises described in the lease shall be open to the public for free hunting and fishing privileges, then the lease may be for any period of time, not to exceed twenty-five (25) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
