AN ACT RELATING TO CRIMES AND PUNISHMENTS; AMENDING  
21 O.S. 1981, SECTION 1241, AS AMENDED BY SECTION  
1, CHAPTER 54, O.S.L. 1985 (21 O.S. SUPP. 1990,  
SECTION 1241), WHICH RELATES TO PENALTY FOR  
FURNISHING TOBACCO PRODUCTS TO MINORS; MODIFYING  
PENALTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 1981, Section 1241, as  
amended by Section 1, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 1985 (21 O.S. Supp. 1990,  
Section 1241), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1241. Any person who shall furnish to any minor by  
gift, sale or otherwise any cigarettes, cigarette papers, cigars,  
snuff, chewing tobacco, or any other form of tobacco product shall  
be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be  
sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Twenty-five Dollars  
(\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) ~~and be confined~~

~~in the county jail not less than ten (10) days nor more than ninety  
(90) days for each offense~~ for the first offense and not less than  
Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars  
(\$500.00) for a subsequent offense.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
