AN ACT RELATING TO SCHOOLS; AMENDING 70 O.S. 1991,
SECTION 1210.802, WHICH RELATES TO APPOINTMENTS TO
TASK FORCE 2000; MODIFYING APPOINTMENTS; PROVIDING
FOR TERMS; AUTHORIZING REAPPOINTMENTS; LIMITING
NUMBER OF TERMS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1991, Section 1210.802, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1210.802 A. The Task Force shall be composed of thirty-one (31) members. The Governor shall appoint nine initial members, the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint nine initial members and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint nine initial members. Beginning July 1, 1992, and every two (2) years thereafter, the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall each appoint three new members of the Task Force 2000 to replace their initial appointees. The total appointed membership of Task Force 2000 shall remain at twenty-seven (27) members. Persons appointed on and after July 1, 1992, shall serve six-year

terms on Task Force 2000. The members of the Council shall be selected for outstanding knowledge and leadership in their fields. The ~~foregoing~~ initial twenty-seven (27) members shall serve at the pleasure of the authority by whom appointed or until the new members are appointed as provided for in this section. Any member may be reappointed, provided however, no member shall serve more than two terms. State Superintendent of Public Instruction, the Director of the State Department of Vocational and Technical Education, the Chancellor of the Oklahoma State Regents of Higher Education, and the Secretary of Education shall be ex officio nonvoting members.

B. The chairperson of the Task Force shall be chosen by the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate jointly and shall be one of the thirty-one members. On and after July 1, 1992, and each two (2) years thereafter a new chairperson shall be jointly appointed to serve a two-year term. The vice-chairperson shall be elected by the members of the Task Force.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1992.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
