BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1022 of Title 59, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In the interest of protecting the health and sanitation of the citizens of this state, and for the purpose of establishing grounds for administrative sanctions for licensed plumbers, the 1990/1992 supplement edition of the Building Officials and Code Administrators (BOCA) National Plumbing Code shall be deemed to be the applicable regulation for the installation of plumbing where no ordinance or regulation of a governmental subdivision applies. Provided, however, the standards set forth in Section P-1202.1 of the 1990/1992 supplement edition of the BOCA National Plumbing Code shall be the applicable regulation in all cases. Any revisions to the 1990/1992 supplement edition of the BOCA National Plumbing Code which are published after the effective date of this act shall become applicable within one hundred twenty (120) days after the last day of the month the revisions become effective.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
