AN ACT RELATING TO CITIES AND TOWNS; REQUIRING
MEMBERS OF A MUNICIPAL GOVERNING BODY TO ATTEND A
CERTAIN WORKSHOP; PROVIDING FOR CURRICULUM,
REGISTRATION FEES AND LOCATIONS FOR SUCH WORKSHOPS;
PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8-114 of Title 11, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each person elected for the first time as a member of a
municipal governing body on or after January 1, 1993, shall be
required to attend the Governing Officials Institute within ninety
(90) days after taking the oath of office. The Institute shall
consist of twelve (12) hours of instruction. A certificate of
completion shall be awarded to those persons who attend and
successfully complete the workshop.

B. The curriculum for the Institute shall be developed by the
Oklahoma Municipal League and shall include but not be limited to:
parliamentary procedure; municipal budget process; Oklahoma Open

Meeting Act; ethics; conflict of interest; and purchasing procedures.

C. A registration fee to defray the estimated costs of presenting the workshop may be charged.

D. The Institute shall be held in at least two locations in the state as determined by the Oklahoma Municipal League.

E. Each official designated to receive filings from candidates for municipal offices or in the case of officials nominated and elected for municipal offices at town meetings, the presiding officer of the town meeting shall notify the candidate of the requirement for attendance at the Institute as provided for in this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
