

ENGROSSED HOUSE

AN ACT RELATING TO SCHOOLS; AMENDING 70 O.S. 1991,  
SECTION 1210.512, WHICH RELATES TO THE OKLAHOMA  
SCHOOL TESTING PROGRAM ACT; PROVIDING ACCESS TO  
CERTAIN MATERIALS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1991, Section 1210.512, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1210.512 A. ~~No~~ Except as otherwise provided for in subsection B of this section, no person shall provide any test materials, including, but not limited to, test booklets, and teacher's test administration manuals, ~~and student pretest materials~~ administered or intended for administration to any student pursuant to the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act to any teacher employed by any school district in this state or to any other person providing services to a school as a test monitor prior to the date on which the test is administered to the students.

B. Materials furnished by any company providing tests required by the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act, Section 1210.505 et seq. of this title, which are intended to aid teachers in administering the tests, or parents or students in preparation for the tests may be provided to students, teachers or any other person providing service to a school as a test monitor.

C. Any person providing any test to a teacher or test monitor in violation of subsection A of this section, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by the imposition of a fine not exceeding Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00).

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
