BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 121.3 of Title 20, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. In addition to any other qualifications required by law, judges of the district court hearing juvenile and domestic relations cases shall be required to complete the training programs required by this section.

B. The Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court shall provide by rule or by order for a program of initial orientation and a program of continuing education for judges of the district court having substantial juvenile or domestic relations docket responsibilities. The curriculum for the orientation and the continuing education programs shall include, but not be limited to, training in juvenile law and procedures, domestic relations law and procedures, family dynamics, child abuse and neglect, and the children and youth service system as defined by Section 600 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
