AN ACT RELATING TO MULTICOUNTY JAILS; DIRECTING THE
LEGISLATIVE SERVICE BUREAU TO CONDUCT A STUDY;
AUTHORIZING USE OF CONSULTANTS OR CONSULTING FIRMS;
PROVIDING PROCEDURES FOR SELECTION OF CONSULTANTS;
PROVIDING FOR NONCODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Legislative Service Bureau shall conduct a study of the feasibility of establishing multicounty jail facilities in this state. At the direction of the Joint Committee on Fiscal Operations, the Legislative Service Bureau may contract for the services of appropriate consultants or consulting firms to assist the Bureau in the conducting of the study. The Legislative Service Bureau shall select consultants on the basis of a request for proposal which shall be developed by the Joint Committee on Fiscal Operations.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1992.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
