AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY;
PROHIBITING APPLICATION OF OUT-OF-STATE SEWAGE
SLUDGE IN CERTAIN CASES; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2304.2 of Title 63, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The practice of plowing out-of-state municipal wastewater sludge
into or applying out-of-state municipal wastewater sludge onto the
soil surface is hereby prohibited if such site is in or over a

principal groundwater resource or recharge area as defined by the Oklahoma Geological Survey.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
