(STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEMS - BENEFIT INCREASE FOR
CERTAIN PERSONS -
EMERGENCY)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 49-143.2 of Title 11, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any
person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and
Retirement System as of June 30, 1991, shall receive a five percent
(5%) increase in said benefits on July 1, 1992.

B. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 49-106.1 of this
title, any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive or
has received during calendar years 1989 through 1992 pursuant to
repealed Section 49-136 of this title, shall be used to offset the
increase in benefits provided in subsection A of this section.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 50-136.2 of Title 11, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System as of June 30, 1991, shall receive a five percent (5%) increase in said benefits on July 1, 1992.

B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive or has received during calendar years 1989 through 1992 pursuant to repealed Section 50-120 of this title, shall be used to offset the increase in benefits provided in subsection A of this section.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104F of Title 20, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person receiving benefits from the Uniform Retirement System for Justices and Judges as of June 30, 1991, shall receive a five percent (5%) increase in said benefits on July 1, 1992.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-305.3a of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System as of June 30, 1991, shall receive a five percent (5%) increase in said benefits on July 1, 1992.

SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 17-116.1a of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person receiving benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma as of June 30, 1991, shall receive a five percent (5%) increase in said benefits on July 1, 1992.

SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 930.4 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System as of June 30, 1991, shall receive a five percent (5%) increase in said benefits on July 1, 1992.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
