AN ACT RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS; AMENDING SECTION  
22 OF ENROLLED SENATE BILL NO. 415 OF THE 1ST  
SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, WHICH  
RELATES TO A LAPSE DATE; MODIFYING SUCH PROVISION  
PROVIDING FOR THIRTY-MONTH MONIES; AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 22 of Enrolled Senate  
Bill No. 415 of the 1st Session of the 43rd Oklahoma Legislature, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 22. The appropriations made by this act shall not be  
subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for  
encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)  
months from the date ~~this~~ said act is approved.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
