EFFECTIVE DATE)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-553 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Medical Center shall design and implement a statewide general public education program concerning:

1. The need for bone marrow donors;
2. The procedures required to become registered as a potential bone marrow donor, including procedures for determining the tissue type of a person; and
3. The medical procedures a donor must undergo to donate bone marrow or other sources of blood stem cells.

B. The Oklahoma Medical Center shall make special efforts to educate and recruit citizens of this state with a special emphasis on minority populations to volunteer as potential bone marrow donors. Means of communication shall include, but not be limited to, use of newspapers, radio and television, and placement of educational materials in appropriate health care facilities, blood

banks and agencies of the state and political subdivisions of the state. Educational materials shall be provided by the Oklahoma Medical Center to all places where driver's licenses and licenses for identification only are issued or renewed.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
