(PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS - SECURITY GUARD AND
PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR ACT - CODIFICATION -
EFFECTIVE DATE)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1750.14 of Title 59, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any
person who for a fee apprehends or attempts to apprehend a
defendant, who has failed to appear before any court of this state
or another state or any federal court as required by law and has
forfeited bail, shall be licensed pursuant to the provisions of the
Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator Act.

B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to law
enforcement officers of any jurisdiction, or any individual who
pledges property as security for a bail bond but does not receive or
is not promised a fee or charge for providing the security.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
