AN ACT RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; AMENDING 47 O.S.  
1991, SECTION 15-104, WHICH RELATES TO ADOPTION OF  
SIGN MANUAL; REQUIRING ADOPTION OF CERTAIN MANUAL;  
DELETING REQUIREMENT OF CONFORMITY WITH CURRENT  
UNIFORM SYSTEM; UPDATING REFERENCE; AND PROVIDING  
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 15-104, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 15-104. The State ~~Highway~~ Transportation Commission shall adopt ~~a manual and specifications for a uniform system of traffic-control devices~~ the United States Department of Transportation Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways for use upon all public roads, streets and highways within this state. ~~Such uniform system shall correlate with and, so far as possible, conform to the system then current as approved by the American Association of State Highway Officials, and the~~ The manual so adopted may be amended or revised from time to time as the Commission may deem necessary. The manual so adopted and any amendments or revisions thereof shall be published by the State ~~Highway~~ Transportation Commission and one copy thereof shall be

distributed free of charge to the local governing bodies of counties and incorporated cities and towns.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
