AN ACT RELATING TO ROADS, BRIDGES AND FERRIES;
REQUIRING THE OKLAHOMA TURNPIKE AUTHORITY TO
CONSTRUCT A CERTAIN TOLLGATE AND INTERCHANGE;
PROHIBITING THE OKLAHOMA TURNPIKE AUTHORITY FROM
CHANGING RATES AS A RESULT OF THE TOLLGATE;
REQUIRING THE OKLAHOMA TURNPIKE AUTHORITY TO SUBMIT
PROGRESS REPORT; REQUIRING THE OKLAHOMA TURNPIKE
AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT ENTRY AND EXIT RAMPS UNDER
CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1705.6 of Title 69, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall construct, by December 31,
1994, an interchange with a tollgate and full entry and exit ramps
in the vicinity of Luther on the turnpikes in Oklahoma County. The
Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall not reduce or increase the toll
rate charged to users of the Turner Turnpike as a result of the
construction of the Luther interchange. The Authority shall issue a
progress report on the Luther interchange by December 31, 1992, to

the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1705.7 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall construct, maintain and repair an entry and exit ramp for access to any economic development project with a completion cost in excess of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) which is or has been constructed in the vicinity of an Oklahoma turnpike.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
