AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC FINANCE; AUTHORIZING THE  
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ENTER INTO CERTAIN  
CONTRACTS; AUTHORIZING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF  
HEALTH TO PROMULGATE CERTAIN RULES AND DEVELOP  
CERTAIN PROCEDURES; REQUIRING IMPLEMENTATION OF  
SYSTEM BY DATE; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION;  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 41.16a of Title 62, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Department of Health is authorized to enter into  
contracts with third party administrators to establish a system for  
processing claims for payment pursuant to the United States  
Department of Agriculture Women, Infants and Children Supplemental  
Nutrition Program.

B. The State Board of Health shall promulgate rules and develop  
procedures necessary for implementation and administration of the

system. The State Department of Health shall implement the system by January 1, 1993.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1992.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
