AN ACT RELATING TO THE STATE BANKING DEPARTMENT;
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THERETO; STATING THE
PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF
EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING BUDGETARY LIMITATIONS;
PROVIDING SALARY SCHEDULE FOR CERTAIN POSITIONS;
PROVIDING A LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN OPERATIVE
DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Banking Department from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the following amount or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Banking Department by law:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

upon the State Banking Department by law shall be set by the Bank Commissioner. The State Banking Department for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. The annual compensation for the unclassified employee positions utilized in the operation of the State Banking Department during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following schedule:

The minimum and maximum salary amounts listed in this section shall not constitute an appropriation, but are listed for the purpose of establishing salary ranges, exclusive of overtime pay.

SECTION 4. The appropriation made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 5. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
