AN ACT RELATING TO THE COUNCIL ON LAW ENFORCEMENT  
EDUCATION AND TRAINING; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS  
THERE TO; STATING PURPOSES; LIMITING EXPENDITURES TO  
SUPPORT POLYGRAPH EXAMINERS BOARD; PROVIDING FOR  
THE DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES; LIMITING  
THE SALARY OF THE DIRECTOR; PROVIDING FOR BUDGETARY  
LIMITATIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE BUDGET WORK PROGRAM  
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN ENTITIES AND ACTIVITIES;  
PROVIDING LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN OPERATIVE DATE;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law  
Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise  
appropriated from the C.L.E.E.T. Fund for the fiscal year ending  
June 30, 1992, the following amount or so much thereof as may be  
necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Council on Law  
Enforcement Education and Training by law:

Personal Services	\$1,003,266.00
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Other Operating Expenses 551,893.00

TOTAL \$1,555,159.00

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the following amount or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law:

Personal Services \$242,793.00

Other Operating Expenses 75,450.00

TOTAL \$318,243.00

SECTION 3. The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training shall not expend more than Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$14,500.00) to support the Polygraph Examiners Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992.

SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law shall be set by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Forty Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-five Dollars (\$40,985.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992. The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 5. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 41.7 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training shall file its budget work program with the Director of State Finance and the Legislative Service Bureau for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, to include the following budget entities and activities: Administration, Training, and Security Guard and Private Investigator Regulation.

SECTION 6. The appropriations made by Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 7. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
