

ENGROSSED SENATE
BILL NO. 612

AN ACT RELATING TO COUNTY CLERKS; AUTHORIZING COUNTY
CLERKS TO COMPUTERIZE GRANTOR-GRANTEE INDEX SYSTEM;
STATING REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPUTERIZED SYSTEM;
PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC ACCESS TO SYSTEM; REQUIRING
PROTECTION OF THE DATA BASE; REQUIRING CLERK TO
MAINTAIN NUMERICAL INDEX SYSTEM AND MAKE SAID INDEX
AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 291.1 of Title 19, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Each county clerk, upon the installation of an automated
alphabetical grantor-grantee index system, may, at his or her
discretion, dispense with the numerical index referred to in Section
291 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The automated system must
be maintained in a computer environment acceptable to industry
standards with terminals available to the public. Provisions shall
be made to provide for protection of the data base against

alteration and as a permanent record. If the county clerk elects to dispense with the original numerical index, he or she must make that index available to the public and it shall include all entries up to the first entry in the automated grantor-grantee index system.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
