AN ACT RELATING TO COURT REPORTERS; AMENDING 20 O.S.
1991, SECTION 1501, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF
ENROLLED HOUSE BILL NO. 1766 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF
THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, WHICH RELATES TO THE
STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS OF OFFICIAL SHORTHAND
REPORTERS; CREATING THE STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS OF
OFFICIAL SHORTHAND REPORTERS; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 20 O.S. 1991, Section 1501, as
amended by Section 2 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1766 of the 2nd
Session of the 43rd Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
follows:

Section 1501. There is hereby ~~re-created~~ created, to continue
until July 1, 1996, in accordance with the provisions of the
Oklahoma Sunset Law, the State Board of Examiners of Official
Shorthand Reporters which shall consist of five (5) members, all of
whom shall be certified shorthand reporters. The members shall be
persons who have been, for at least five (5) years prior to their
appointment to the Board, residents of this state and certified

shorthand reporters. All members shall be appointed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court and shall serve in staggered terms, each for a period of five (5) years except for the initial appointees. No member may serve more than one term in succession. The Board shall elect from its membership a chairman and a secretary. Three members shall constitute a quorum. The Board may adopt a seal for its official use. All actions of the Board shall be supervised by the Supreme Court and be subject to approval by the Court.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
